TECHNOLOGY AND COMPUTER REQUIREMENTS

MoodleTM is the learning management system used by St Andrew's Greek Orthodox Theological College for its eLearning units.

Students can use a PC, MAC or Linux based computer.

There are no minimum hardware requirements, as long as the computer is capable of running Microsoft Office 2003 (or newer) or Open Office (open-source; available for free download at http://www.openoffice.org/).

Internet Explorer 6 or newer, Safari (version 3 and later) and Firefox (version 2 and later) are recommended.

Also Adobe Acrobat Viewer 7 or newer (or a similar program) is required to view PDF files for online units (available for free download on the Adobe website at http://www.adobe.com/products/reader.html).

Adobe Acrobat Standard (or equivalent) is recommended to convert word documents to pdf for greater content security before emailing or posting although MS Word (or equivalent) is acceptable.

Students are reminded that computer hardware and software are often available for purchase from various vendors at academic or student prices that are well below the standard retail price.

Broadband internet (e.g. ADSL, cable, wireless) is strongly recommended; not dialup.

Students must have an active email address which is checked regularly.
